

Environmental Policy

The company implements the following measures in order to minimize its environmental footprint:

- Compliance with applicable legislation relating to environmental protection.
- There is no hazardous waste.
- All items handled are fully recyclable and comply with the EU Regulation 2025/40 (PPWR).
- Natural resources and energy are used responsibly:
 - through appropriate design to minimize the weight of the products manufactured in order to use less plastic according to the Article 15 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.
 - through the use of recycled raw materials for the production of products according to the Article 15 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40.
 - through the gradual replacement of production machines with electric or hybrid ones that have significantly reduced electricity and lubricant consumption.
 - reusing scraps and discarded products from the production process, which are ground in mills and fed back into the machines.
 - collecting thermal energy from air compressors via heat exchangers and using it for air conditioning.
 - improving the energy efficiency of the equipment used by replacing hydraulic parts with electric ones.
- Photovoltaic panels have been installed, generating a large part of the electricity consumed.
- Rainwater is collected in a tank and used in firefighting systems.
- Waste from the production process or household waste, e.g. plastic, paper, mineral oils, is collected in containers/bins and recycled in collaboration with recycling companies.
- The environmental responsibility of the company's staff and associates is encouraged.
